

Tuesday March 12<sup>th</sup> 1805

My Dear dear George - How many many thanks I  
 have to return you for your most dear kind note I received on  
 Sunday; how glad I shall be if you really are able to  
 come here next week; it is indeed an accomplishment the of-  
 fering you that you cannot come the same, yet I will not  
 allow myself to think there is a possibility of my seeing  
 you so early as next Tuesday, as I should be really dis-  
 appointed if you did not come - You bid me tell you  
 a great deal about myself, & I feel sure you are in  
 earnest, for you have spelt me with your independence,  
 indeed if I did not think that I could not write when  
 so uninteresting a subject is my particular self; I am  
 but indifferent; & was very much afraid till yesterday & the  
 day before that I should have one of my Indian Spans;  
 however the day I am better as I hope it was a false  
 alarm - My dear beloved thing has been remarkably  
 well ever since we were at Windsor, & when I consulted  
 about the tendency his continued persistance about the  
 child; you will of course have more of this from  
 your father as you may form your own judgement -  
 as to myself my opinion & language was more desir'd  
 & as the dear Angelic L. is my sole object it is his  
 happiness & peace of mind I pray for - This however

is not more peacefully inclined than when we parted  
but when the whole I am very little of its substance  
for in my opinion is not human this subject is more  
troubled when, & not being up to something & making  
I shall sleep, giving in silence at all I see & lamenting  
how sad it is that there is no more selfishness in the  
world for it is not to wish that that is what binds the  
world & opinion of many in their hearts - And I hope for  
my very dear dear soul; my affect has to my dear  
Savage & my dear children & do me the justice to  
believe that in the midst of all my prejudices the  
thought of your being one a little in my heart  
comfort & support for me are less than little  
more tenderly, deeply & affect than does
