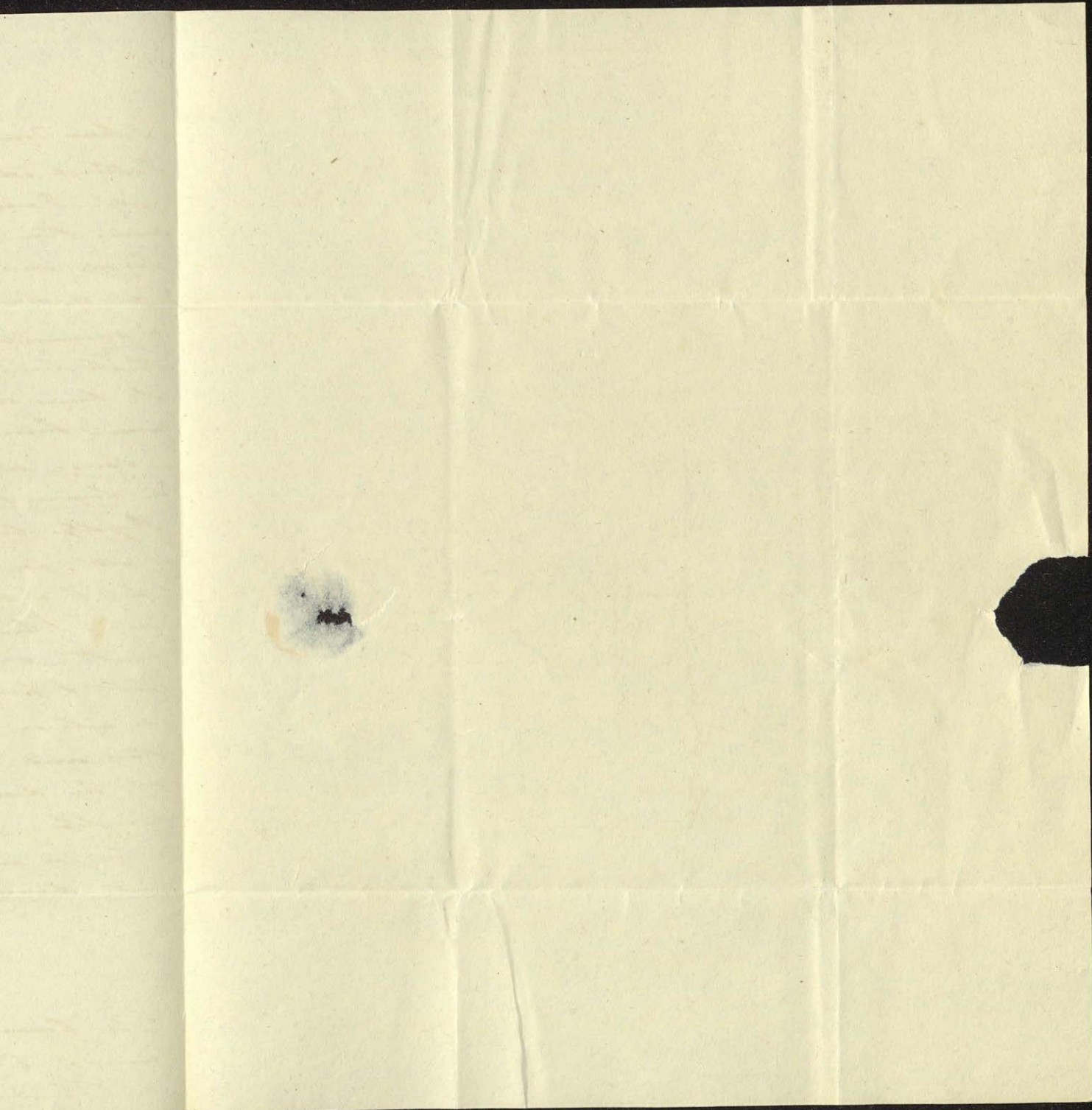


I show you what is before in writing to J. Sturges & some
