Prince Amelia, being, tho' weak in body, yet,
of sound mind, memory & understanding, do make
this my last Will and Testament in manner
following.

I give & bequeathe to my dearest Brother George
Prince of Wales my Sardonyx Snuff box set
& gratitude for the invariable & unbounded
kindness, which from my birth I have experienced
from him, & which tho' I never can repay
I wish most thankfully to acknowledge

I give & bequeathe to my dear Brother
Adolphus Frederick Duke of Cambridge
dear Marys pictures as tokens of my regard
& gratitude for the trouble he is good as to take
in being my joint Executor with the
Prince of Wales.

I give and bequeathe to my dear sister
the Princess Mary my Garnet watch & chain
given to me by the Queen, and to her by the
King as tokens of my affection and gratitude
for her kind and unremitting attentions
to me during my illness and my Turquoise
set of earrings, Necklace Bracelets and Brooch
set in diamonds and Gold Chains. And tho' I
do not here particularly name any other Members
my family I hereby request they will be
assured of my affection and of my prayers for
their long enjoyment of every earthly blessing.

I give and bequeathe to my dear and

most valuable friend the Honble General
Charles Fitz Roy, all my Personal Property
(with the exception of the above mentioned
Legacies) of which I may be possessed at the time
of my Death, Jewels, Plate, Trunkets of every
sort, Books, Prints, Pictures, Cloaths, and
every article of Furniture which is my
Property, either by gift or purchase - also
every Box, Paper, and Letter which may
belong to me - And I also give and bequeath
to the said Honble General Charles Fitz Roy
any Money which may be in my possession
or due to me at the time of my death. And
this I do as the only proof I can ever give him
of the high Sense which I entertain not only
of his zealous attachment and Devotion to the
King, my beloved Father, but of the honorable
and virtuous Manner in which he has for
a long series of years possessed my entire
esteem and affection, and for which reasons
I hereby venture humbly but earnestly to
express my anxious hopes that he may ever
continue to enjoy the esteem and protection
of my Family.

Should my debts to my Sisters the Princess
Mary and Sophia (which I am now regularly
paying by Quarterly Instalments) not be
finally liquidated at the time of my death
I hereby most humbly entreat the King
my beloved Father to add to the many
acts of parental kindness which I have
experienced from him by being

graciously pleased to take these debts into
his kind consideration and not suffer
them to be losers by my death, as he is
well aware that nothing but my youth
and inexperience were the causes of
my contracting them, and that it has
long been the most anxious wish of my
heart to liquidate them with all possible
expedition.

I hereby nominate, constitute and
appoint my dear Brother George Prince
of Wales and my dear Brother Adolphus
Duke of Cambridge, joint
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I here write set my
hand and seal this 20th day of July
one thousand eight hundred and ten
