Second daughter of Thomas first Earl of Pomfret. Born Feb. 14 1725. Married in 1746 the Hon. Esq. Finch, a distinguished diplomatist; by whom she became the mother of George 8<sup>th</sup> Earl of Winchelsea & 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of Nottingham: also of Charlotte & Frances who died unmarried,

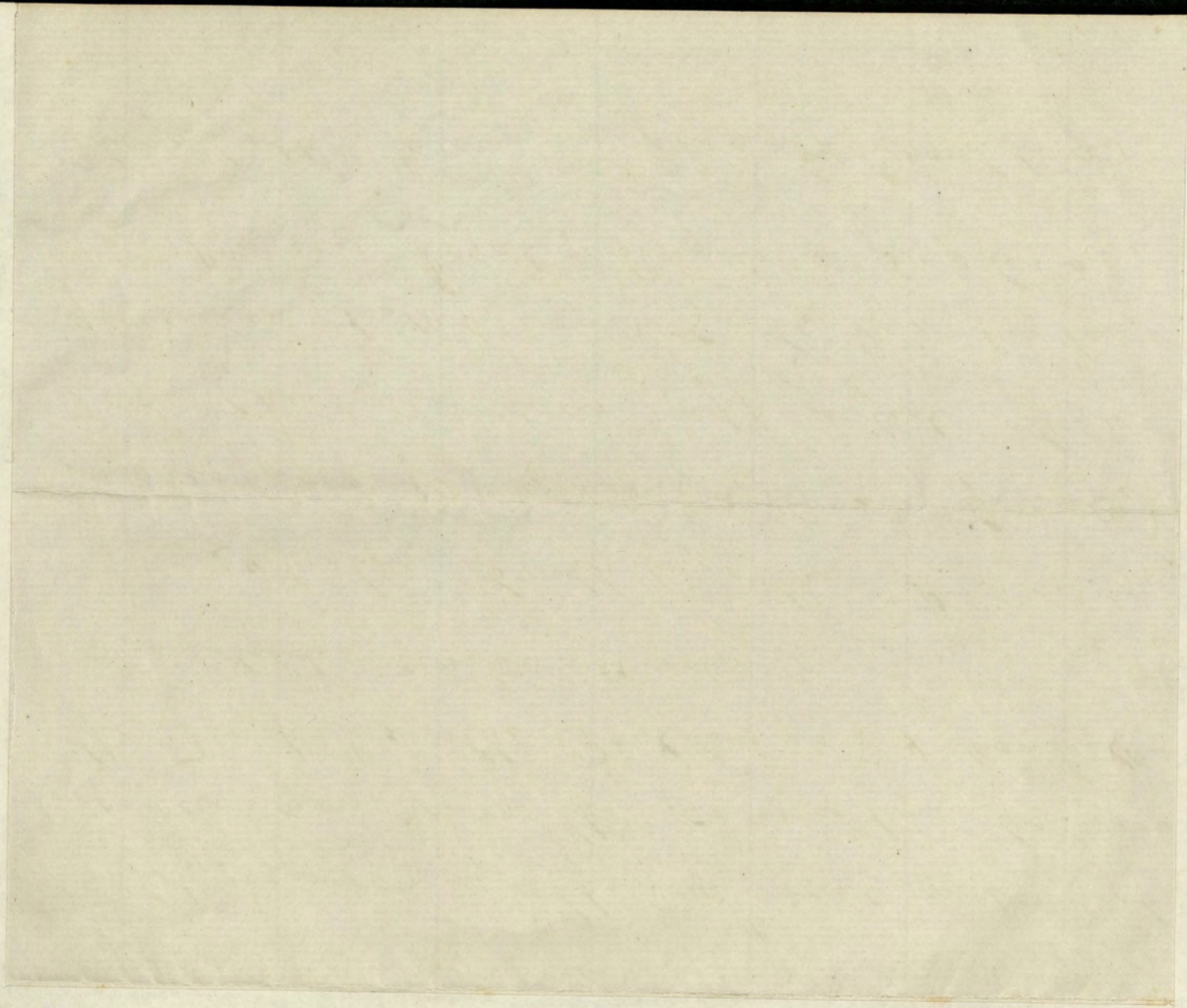

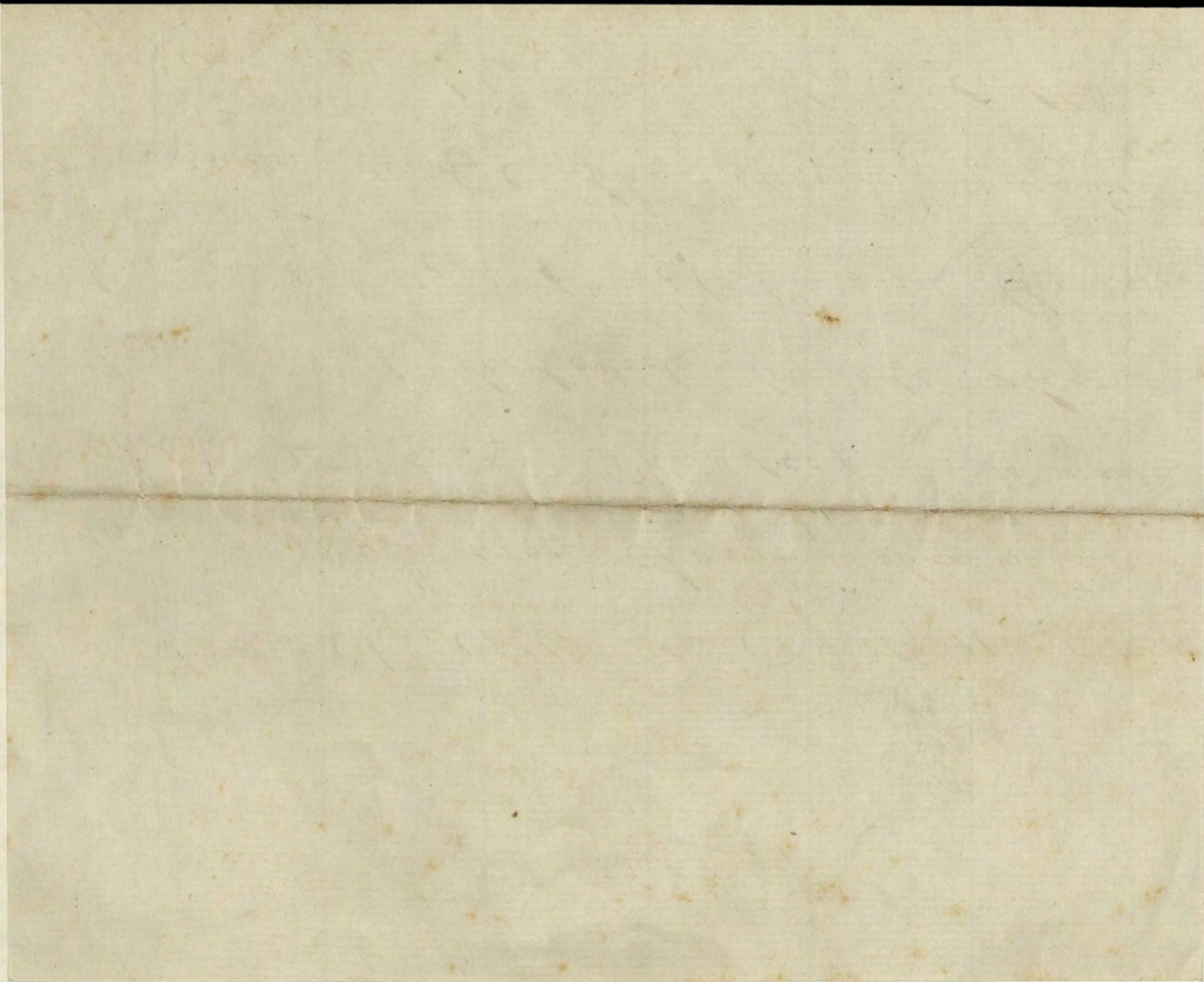
Tophia who married in 1772 Cap<sup>t</sup>  
Fridding, son of the 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of Denbigh  
(so here you have the connection between  
the Finchs & the Friddings) & Henrietta  
who died unmarried.

At the birth of the Prince of  
Wales, Aug. 12. 1762 (afterwards Geo. IV)  
Lady Charlotte was appointed his  
governess & subsequently to his Sisters  
the Princess Royal, Augusta-Sophia,  
Elizabeth, Mary, Sophia & Amelia.





Lady Charlotte died July 11. 1813  
in her 89<sup>th</sup> year. having been a  
widow 47 years. She seems to have  
been much beloved by all her  
Royal pupils & acted as their  
governess until they were quite  
grown up. There are two letters





from Geo. iii to her dated Windsor  
Castle July 13 & July 18. 1800.

Mention is made of Lady  
Charlotte in the diary of Madame  
d'Arblay & the letters of Horace  
Walpole. The latter writes 'Lady  
Charlotte is an accomplished &  
most estimable person.'
