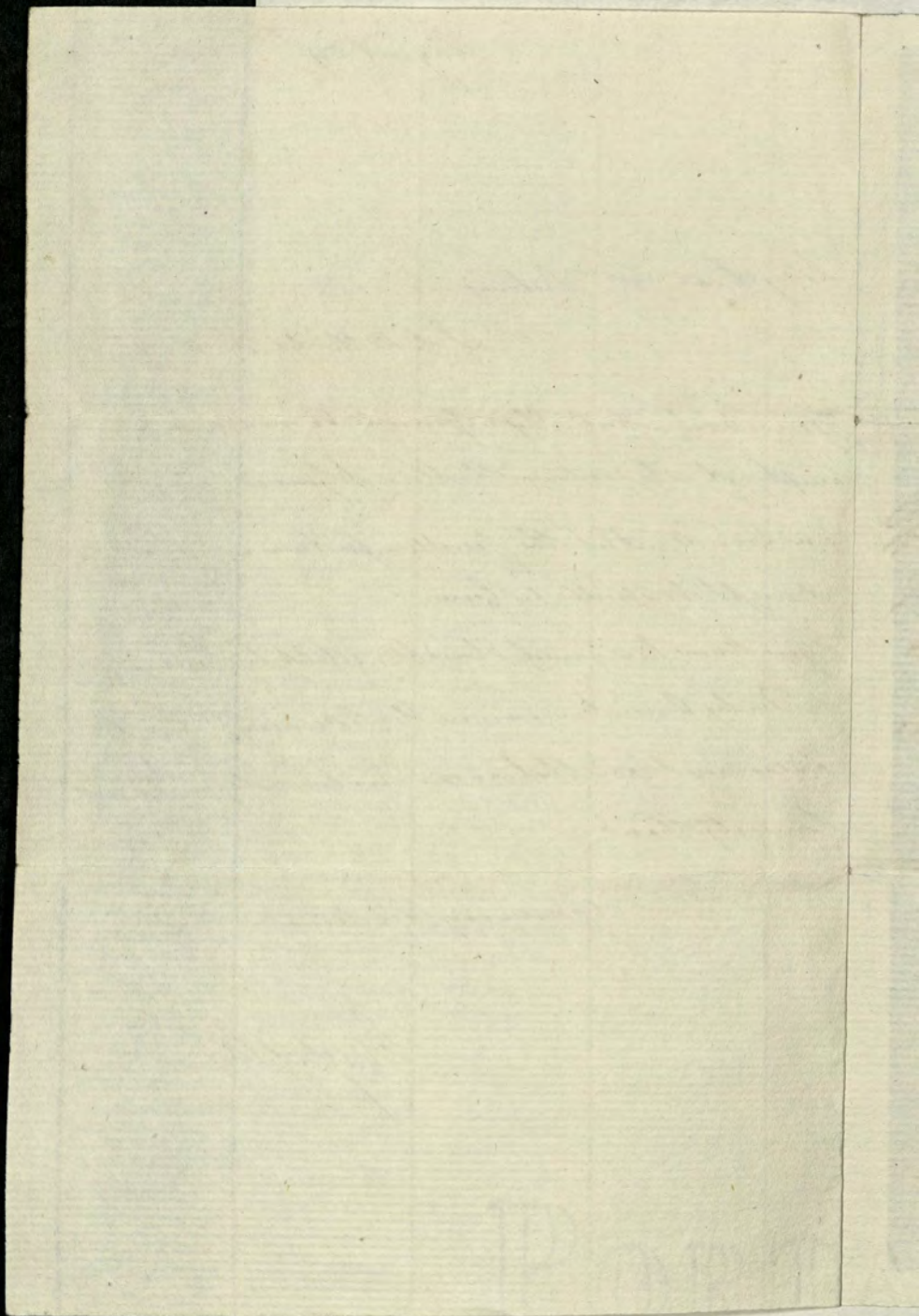
My Dear Mrs. Fielding
