I wish You to take this Letter  
to the King of Prussia, in your Hand,  
to convey to His Majesty, the warmest  
feelings of my personal friendship

Upon the Death of our former  
Brother the Duke of Saxe, the late  
King of Prussia, Father of the late  
Duchess of Saxe, <sup>(Father of his present Majesty)</sup>  
Duchess of Saxe, by a private Treaty


would have become entitled to the re-  
 -stitution of <sup>£</sup>40,000 pounds. Now two  
 your Brothers, the Duke of York, died
