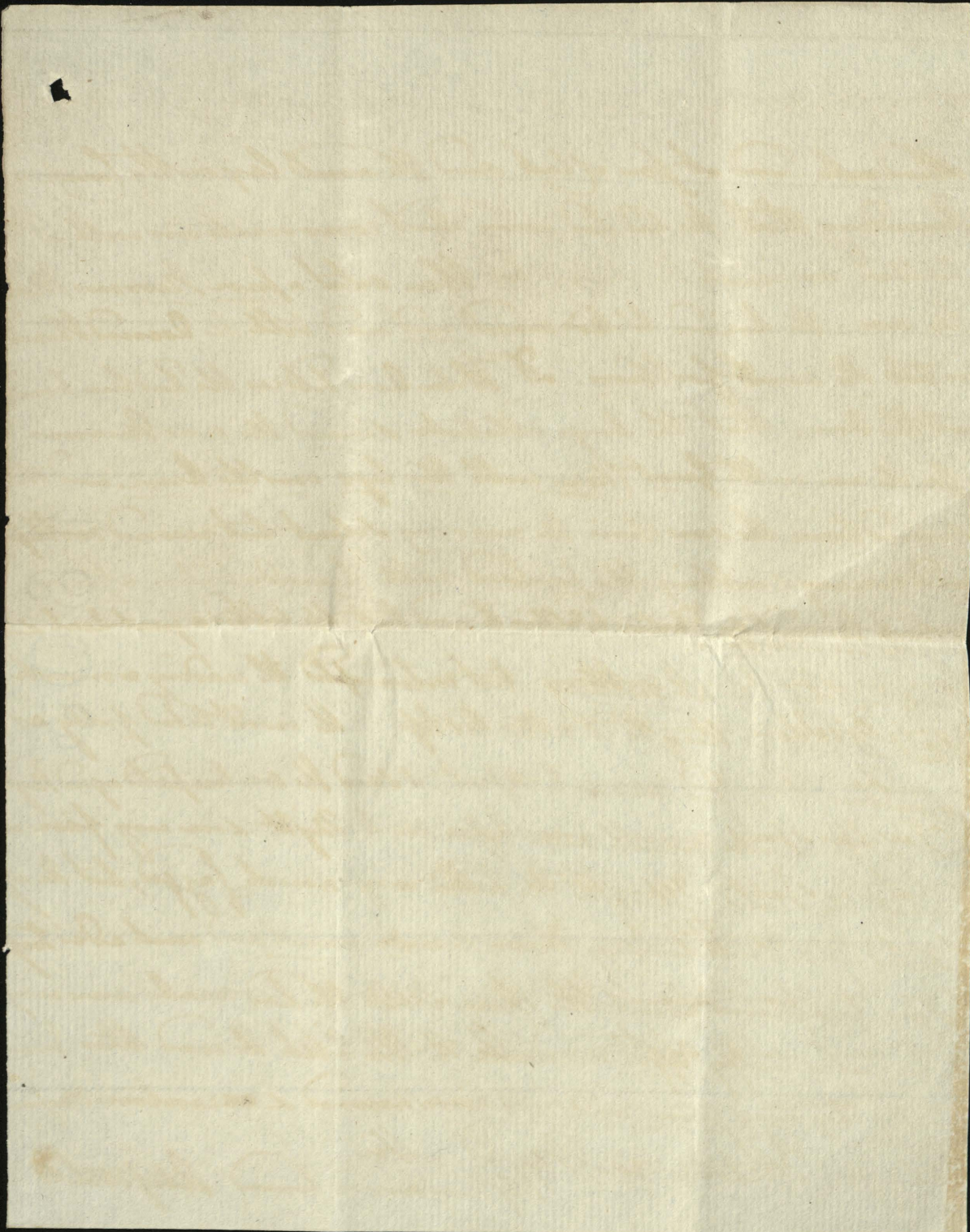


My Dear Sir
