

TO HAVE, HOLD and EXERCISE the faid Office, or place unto you the faid Milliam Brown Hulme by yourfelf or your fufficient Deputy or Deputies, (for whom you shall be answerable) for and during the Term of One Year, or until another shall be appointed, in your stead, you the said Milliam Brown Houlme in being refident in said County and to be Subject to all fuch Laws, Cuftoms, Ordinances, Regulations and Directions, as the High Sheriffs in the feveral Counties in the Kingdom of England, are Subject to, and shall also be Subject to all such Acts of the Province aforefaid, which in any way or manner do or shall relate to the Execution of the Office of Sheriff or Provost Marshall. AND WE DO hereby empower and authorize you to receive and enjoy all and fingular the Rights, Salaries, Allowances, Fees, Profits, Priviledges and Emoluments to the faid Office belonging and appertaining in your faid County, requiring you hereby faithfully and deligently to difcharge the Duties of faid Office as becometh. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caufed the Seal of Our faid Province to be hereunto affix'd. WITNESS Our Trusty and Wellbelov'd John Wentworth Esq, Queulenant Governor Hommander in Chief in and over Our Province of Nova - Scotia, man and its Dependencies, Vice Admiral of the fame &c. &c. &c. at Halifax this Twelfth - Day of June in the Year of Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred

and Vinety two in the Thuly second Year of Our Reign.


