We are to signify unto your Grace
 his Majestys pleasure that you provide &
 deliver to the honble Grey Maynard Esq,
 Yeoman of his Majestys Removing Wardrobe
 the following particulars for his Maj.^{ty} Service
 at Kensington, and Hampton Court viz
 a four post fire Bedsted wth Scarlet Cumblet
 Furniture laid suitable, and a compleat set
 of Bedding, Two pair of Window Curtains -
 the same of the Bed, a hanging Glass, a 4
 Wallnuttree Table wth drawers, and Eighteen
 Wallnuttree Chairs wth matted bottoms. Likewise
 Two four post fire Bedsteds wth Crimson &
 Harateen Furniture laid suitable and Bedding
 compleat, Twelve cane Chairs, one Oval wainscott
 Table, and two wainscott flap Tables. And for
 to doing this shall be your Graces Warrant
 Given under my hand this 11th day of Aug^r 1721
 in the Eight Year of his Maj.^{ty} Reign.
 To his Grace the Duke of Montagu Master
 of his Maj.^{ty} Great Wardrobe or to his Deputy S^r Hobbescarte

The particulars of this Warrant will come to Two Hundred and Forty
 five pounds & thereon for the 23rd August 1721. This Warrant is
 by an exceeding of the sum committed for the expense of the Office
 therefore cannot be executed without a special Order of the
 Hon^{ble} Treasurer

the Great Wardrobe should happen to be
