Hampton Court
Warrant to the Master of the Wardrobe for the Furniture
for the Palace estimated at £6400.0.0

These are to signify unto your Grace his
Majesty's pleasure, that you provide and deliver
to the Hon^{ble} Gray Maynard Esq^r Yeoman of His
Majesty's removing Ward-Robe, the following par-
ticulars of Furniture for his Majesty's service at the
Court, Viz. for the Duke's presence Chamber a Crim-
son Lustring draw up Window Curtain, a Hanging
pier glass in a Walnuttree frame, a Table and a
pair of Stands D^o with leather covers, a pair of
Double Brass arms, and two pair of single D^o. For
His withdrawing Room, two Crimson draw up
Lustring Window Curtains, one round chair, and eight
square stools, Walnuttree Frames, stuffed and covered
with Crimson Mohair, a hanging Glass in a Walnuttree
frame, a Table and a pair of Stands D^o, with leather
Covers, a pair of Double Brass Arms for the Chimney,
and two pair of single D^o. For His Bed Chamber, to be
Hung with Blue Mohair, two draw up blue Lustring
window Curtains, a pier glass in a Walnuttree frame,
a Table and a pair of Stands D^o with leather covers,
a Leather Mattress to his bed, and a Boarded Bottom
to the Bedstead, a Mahogany fire screen, covered with
India paper, a pair of Double wrought Arms to the
Chimney, four glass scones in carved and Gilt
Frames, with two Brass Arms to each, For his dressing
Closet a Mahogany night chair and two white earthen
pans, for his small Light Closet two square Walnuttree

Stools, with matted seats, a Mahogany Flap Table,
a dressing Glass in a Walnuttree Frame, and a pair
of wrought Brass Arms. For his Large light Closet, to
be hung with Blue Mohair, a Blue Lustre draw up
Window Curtain, a dressing chair and four Square
stools Walnuttree Frames, stuffed and covered with
blue Mohair, a Mahogany desk and Bookcase, a Maho-
gany writing Table, two pair of Brass Arms for the
Closet a Mahogany Round Table, on a pillar, a
pair of Brass Arms to the Chimney. For his two
Vallies, two four post Bedsteads on Castors, green
Paraline furniture, two Wainscot flap Tables and
twelve Beech chairs with matted seats. For his Coffee
room, a Square deal table, with a drawer a Wainscot
press bedstead, green Paraline furniture upon Castors
a Wainscot press with doors, shelves &c. and six Beech
chairs with wooden bottoms. For princess Amelia
and princess Caroline two leather mattresses, two
boarded bottoms for their Bedsteads, two Mahogany
night chairs, and four white earthen pans. Two
Mahogany night tables, with green silk Curtains
Two Iron watch Bedsteads, with green samblet furniture
to each. For the Queen a white satin down botstet
and six earthen pans. For princess Mary and princess
Louisa, two Mahogany night chairs and four
white earthen pans, and two Mahogany night
Tables with Blue silk Curtains a Leather mattress
for princess Mary's bed, three draw up blue Lustre
ring Window Curtains for princess Mary's and Louisa's
Bed chamber, six slope Lath field Bedsteads on
Castors frames on Paraline furniture, two dozen of
Walnuttree chairs with matted seats, and three
Dozen

Doren of Beech Chairs, with matted Seats and
six Flap Wainscot tables, six square deal Tables
with drawers, and four Oval Tables for eight
persons each. For the Queens with drawing Room,
Green Genoa Damask to hang the room between the
pictures, and over and under them, and three pair
of D. Damask window Curtains furnished and
two Arm'd chairs and twenty-four square stools
with carved and gilt frames, to be stuffed and
cover'd with D. Damask. For the Triumph Gallery
four Sattles and lighteen square stools carved and
gilt frames, stuffed and cover'd with Green Genoa
Damask. For the Prince of Wales presence Chamber
three draw up crimson Sustaining Window Curtains, two
pair glasses in Walnuttree Frames, two Tables and
two pair of stands D. with Leather covers, a pair of
double wrought Brass Arms to the Chimney, a gilt
Metal Lustre to carry twelve Candles; For
His withdrawing Room, a pair glass in a Walnut
tree Frame, a Table and a pair of stands D. with
Leather covers, a gilt metal Lustre to carry eight
Candles, two crimson draw up Sustaining Window
Curtains, a pair of double wrought Arms to the
Chimney. For his Bed Chamber, two draw up crimson
Sustaining Window Curtains, a Mahogany Fin
cover'd with crimson Damask, a Mahogany night
Table, with crimson silk Curtains, a pair Glass
in a carved and gilt frame, a Table and a pair of
stands D. with Leather covers, two carved and
gilt glass sconces with two Brass Arms to each,
and a pair of wrought Arms to the Chimney, a leather
mattress for the Bed, For the light Closet a Walnut
Tree

Two dressing chairs, and two square stools stuffed
and covered, with crimson Damask, a Mahogany
writing table for the Prince of Wales, a handsome
dressing glass in a gilt frame, and a Mahogany
dressing table, for a dark closet for the Prince of
Wales a Mahogany night chair and two white &
earthen pans. For his page in close waite a Wain-
scot press, bedsted crimson Haratine Furniture a
square deal table with a drawer, six Beech mat-
ted chairs, a pair of crimson Haratine window
curtains, without Valens, for the Ladies Maids of
Honour, other attendants and servants, two spring
Umbrellas, six Walnuttrees chairs, the seats lined &
with a yellow silk and worsted lace, and an ornate
chair D^o, a four post bedsted on castors with
small furnish and vases, for a yellow Damask
Furniture in being, light four post bedsteds on
castors with cup Vases and printed linen fur-
-nitures lined with white callico, and a counter-
point D^o to each. Twenty four pair of printed &
Sinner Window curtains, with gathered Heads
without valens, lined with white callico, twelve
walnuttrees dressing chairs, the seats stuffed and
covered with printed linnen, one walnuttree dressing
chair, with a matted seat, a Mahogany night
chair and two white earthen pans, two four post
bedsteds on castors crimson Haratine Furniture
light four post bedsteds on castors green Haratine
Furniture, six D^o on castors green printed stuff
Furniture, two Wainscot press bedsteds crimson
haratine Furniture, two D^o green haratine Furniture
Four

Four wainscot Table Bedsteads seven compleat
sets of Bedding four sets of Bedding light
pair of Green karatine window Curtains
without Valens, and six pair of Crimson Ditto
without Valens, fifteen hanging Glass in Walnut
tree Frames, seventeen pair of wrought Brass Armes
Eight Mahogany dressing Tables with drawers and
leather covers, eight mahogany flap Tables, Ten dozen
of Walnuttree chairs, Twelve dozen of Buck Chairs,
India Back and matted seats, and six doz of Com-
mon matted chairs, and three dozen of strong chairs
with wooden bottoms, two Wainscot Tables, to Brush
clothes on, eleven oval wainscot dining Tables for
twelve each, two D. for ten each, four D. for eight
each, and four D. six each, three large deal folding
leaves, on tripets for sixteen persons each, five

side Board Tables, four square Wainscot office Table
one wainscot Bread Bin, eight Wainscot presses
with drawers, shelves, doors, &c. two double wainscot
Chest of drawers, and two single D. Two deal Ironing
Tables, one mangle or Calender compleat, eighteen
Wainscot Flap Tables, and eighteen square deal
Tables with drawers, Twelve pair of Brass
Candlesticks with steel snuffers, and Brass pans
to D. Twelve pewter Basons, and twelve D. Chamber
pots. One pair of single Brass Armes, for the
Dukes presence Chamber, To new cover a drawing
Table with black leather, a set of Bedding for
a Table Bedsted, five blew lustring draw up
Window Curtains Lines &c. eight side Santhorn
in

in walnuttree frames, with a Small Brass &
Candlestick in each, a Walnuttree dressing Table
with drawers and Leather Cover, to take in piece
clean and new make up five draw up white
calico window curtains and Valens, a quadrille
Table, cover'd with Green Velvet, trim'd with
Gold lace, and gilt nails, six stained fallow
Quilts, and six pair of Blankets, to compleat
Bedding for four post paraline Bedsteads in being,
to make up a Glass Lustre, out of Crystal in being,
and to provide materials to hang the same. For
Princess Mary and Louisa's Bed Chamber, &
Two walnuttree dressing Chairs, and four square
Stools, to be stuffed and cover'd with Blue
Mohair, For their dressing room four square
stools walnuttree frames to be stuffed and cover'd
with blue Mohair, a pair of Brass arms, to the
chimney, a hanging Glass in a Walnuttree &
frame, a Walnuttree dressing Table, with draw-
ers, and a Leather Cover, for a passage Room
a pair of wrought Brass Arms, For their dining
Room a leather Cover to a Table, a large hanging
pier Glass in a Walnuttree frame, and a pair
of wrought Brass Arms to the chimney, and a
pair of D. to the Room, a mahogany flap Table
two pair of scarlet Haratine window curtains
and Valens, a Board Bottom to princess
Mary's Bed, a chain to hang two Lustres, and
two carved Noses to the ceiling, Green Velvet and
Gold lace to cover the Kings writing Table, to
new gilt the top of a Table, and two pair of
Girandoles

Gerandoles, two dressing chairs, and six square
stools walnuttree frames, stuffed and covered with
green Damask, and two draw up green Lustring
window curtains, and to hang a closet, with green
Damask trim'd, with a lace of the colour, one square
mahogany folding dining Table, and four D. S. S.
board tables. Tichen and wood work for an umbrella
low, to new cover a dressing chair with blue
chair, Gold cord, to go round the top of green dam-
ask hangings, in the Queens with drawing room
silk Linc and Tappell's to hang six sconces, and to
provide gilt chain to hang two Lusters, with Ballon
and roses to the ceiling, a Walnuttree dressing table
with drawers, and a leather cover, and a hanging
glass in a Walnuttree frame, to hang a closet
with crimson haratine, trim'd with a lace of
the colour to alter a leather Mattress, a new leather
mattress to new cover with green mohair and trim
with a lace of the colour, a couch square, and three
pillows in being, one Arm'd chair and six back
chairs walnuttree frames, with green laced seats
six wainscot Breakfast Tables with a drawer to
each, one small Mahogany flap Table, and two
round mahogany Breakfast Tables on pillars and
claw feet, one other small mahogany flap table
two oval wainscot dining tables, one for six and
the other for eight, Two Walnuttree dressing tables,
on castors with leather covers, one walnuttree
dressing chair, and three square stools, matted seats
a new white dimity Mattress, two wainscot press
Bedsteads, crimson Haratine ^{and one d. queen haratine Furniture} furniture, all upon
castors, a four post Bedstead with crimson
Haratine

Caratine Furniture, three foot six Inches wide &
 a compleat set of Bedding for D^o, a frame of a Bed-
 stead and a sacking Bottom for a press Bed, two &
 foot eight Inches wide, a Feather Bed, Bolster, three
 Blankets, and a pillow, and Callico quilt for D^o four
 Mahogany wire Blinds, a Mahogany folding table, a
 mahogany Night Chair and two white lathen pans,
 two side Lanthorns in Walnuttree Frames, a large
 Russia Leather Trunk iron bound, with strong shoot-
 ing Bolts, Lock, key, and Handles, two Wainscot-press-
 es with shelves and Drawers, a new Leather Mattress
 for the King, to take in pieces, scower and new make
 up a yellow Damask Bed Furniture, and two pair
 of Window curtains, and to provide materials and
 necessaries for D^o Two Mahogany Posts for Iron Bed-
 heads, two sets of Bed-heads and sacking Bottoms, also
 to give orders to the Upholsters, Art and Workers, Joiners
 and Cabinet-makers to mend and repair Furniture
 in His Majestys palace there and elsewhere where
 wanting. And for so doing this shall be your Grant
 Warrant of W^m under my hand this 24th day of June
 1737 in the Eleventh year of His Majestys Reign

To His Grace the Duke of Montagu
 Master of His Majestys Great
 Wardrobe, and to His Deputy.
