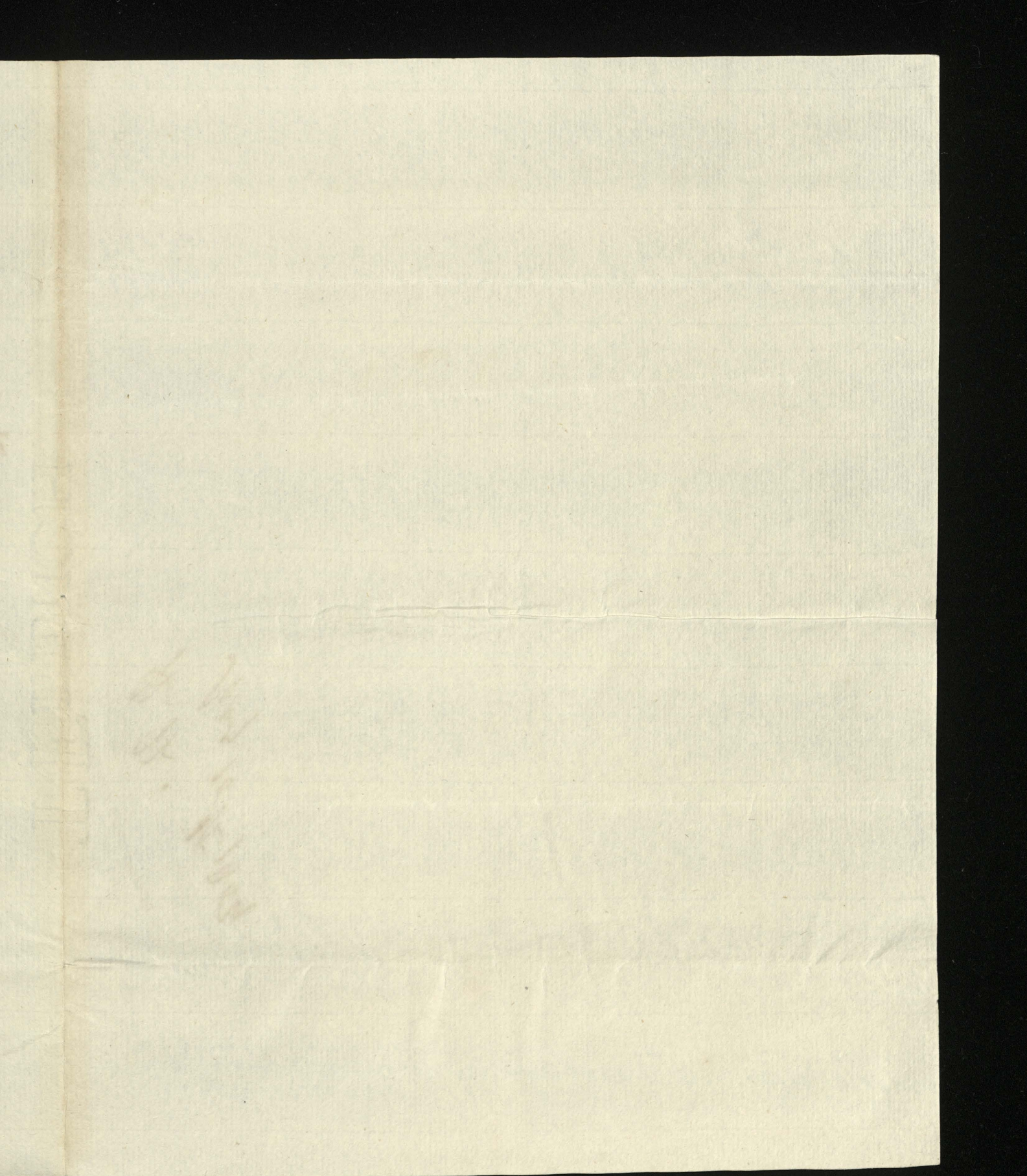
The King has just received M^r. York's note, one
