Poland is bounded on y^e N. by y^e Baltick, Livonia, & Russia. on y^e E. by
 Russia, Lesser Tartary, on y^e S. by Hungary, Transylvania, Moldavia
 & Turkey in Europe; & on y^e W. by Germany. & Baltick; y^e Warta
 y^e Oder, & y^e Neper which runs into y^e Black Sea,
 which goes into y^e Black Sea, y^e Dwina which runs
 into y^e Gulf of Livonia; y^e Bog which goes into y^e Black Sea
 y^e Vistula; & y^e Niemen into y^e Baltick
 y^e only Mountains are y^e Craspach which separate it from
 Hungary.

Poland is divided into 4 large Parts viz. Great Poland, Little
 Poland, Red Russia, & Prussia

Great Poland, is subdivided into Poland proper, Lujavia, & Masovia.
 Little Poland, into y^e Palatinies of Cracow, Sandomir, & Lublin.

Red Russia, into Russia proper, Volhynia, & Podolia
 & Prussia, into Polish Prussia, & Ducal Prussia, y^e latter belongs
 to y^e Elect. of Brandenburg.

Great D^y of Lithuania is bounded on y^e N. by Livonia & Russia,
 on y^e E. by Russia; on y^e S. by Red Russia; & on y^e W. by Prussia & y^e
 Baltick

it is divided into 4 parts viz. Courland, Polish Livonia, Samogitia,
 Lithuania proper, & White Russia.

It provides y^e greatest part of Germany wth Corn, there are besides
 mines of Iron, Lead, Silver, & one of Quick-silver, & also Flax, Kide,
 Salt, Nitre, vitriol, Timber &c. so y^t y^e people might be
 Rich if they were allow^d to manufacture y^e Produce of their
 Country; & to reap y^e fruits of their Labour.
