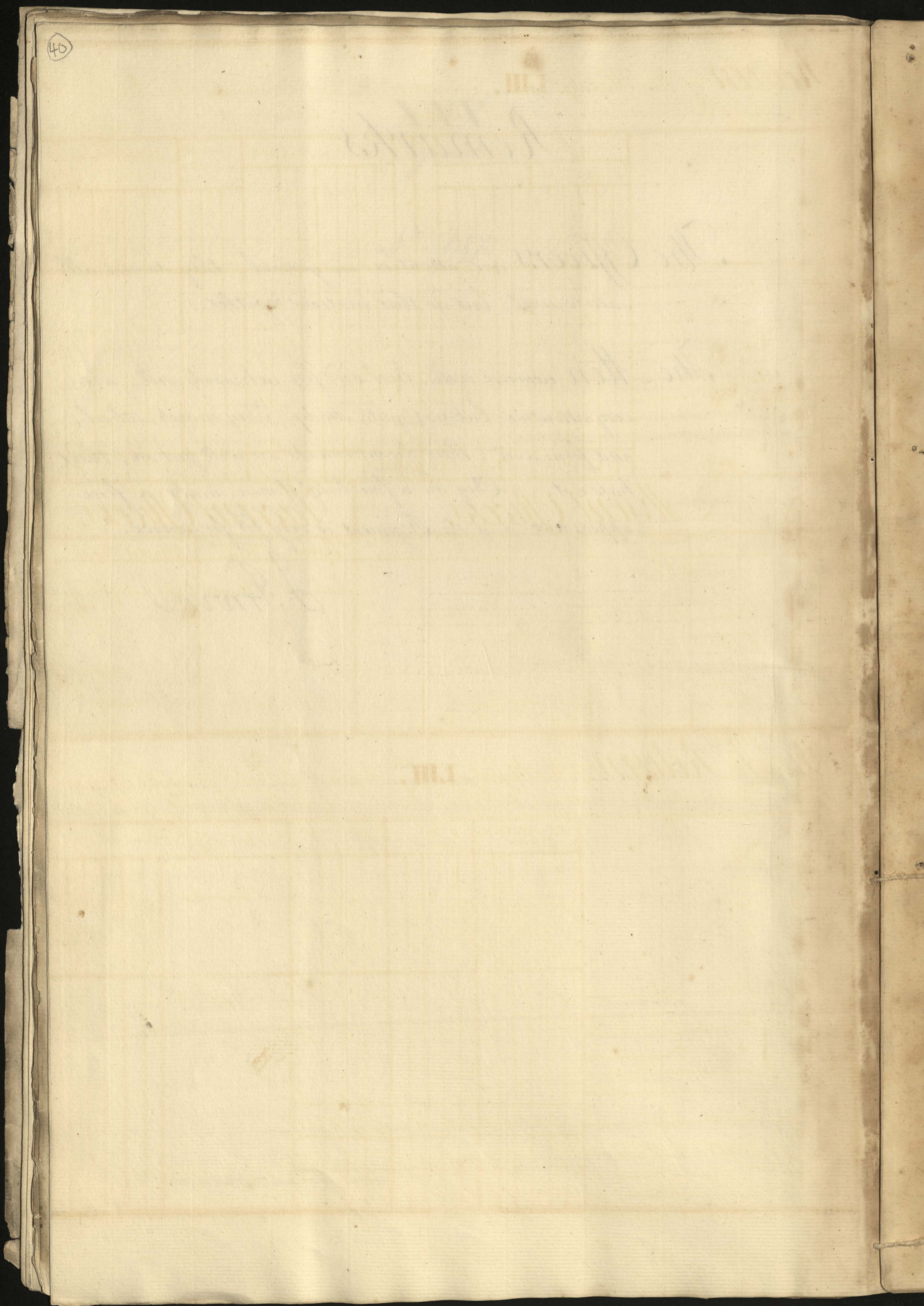
# Remarks
