Dear Sir

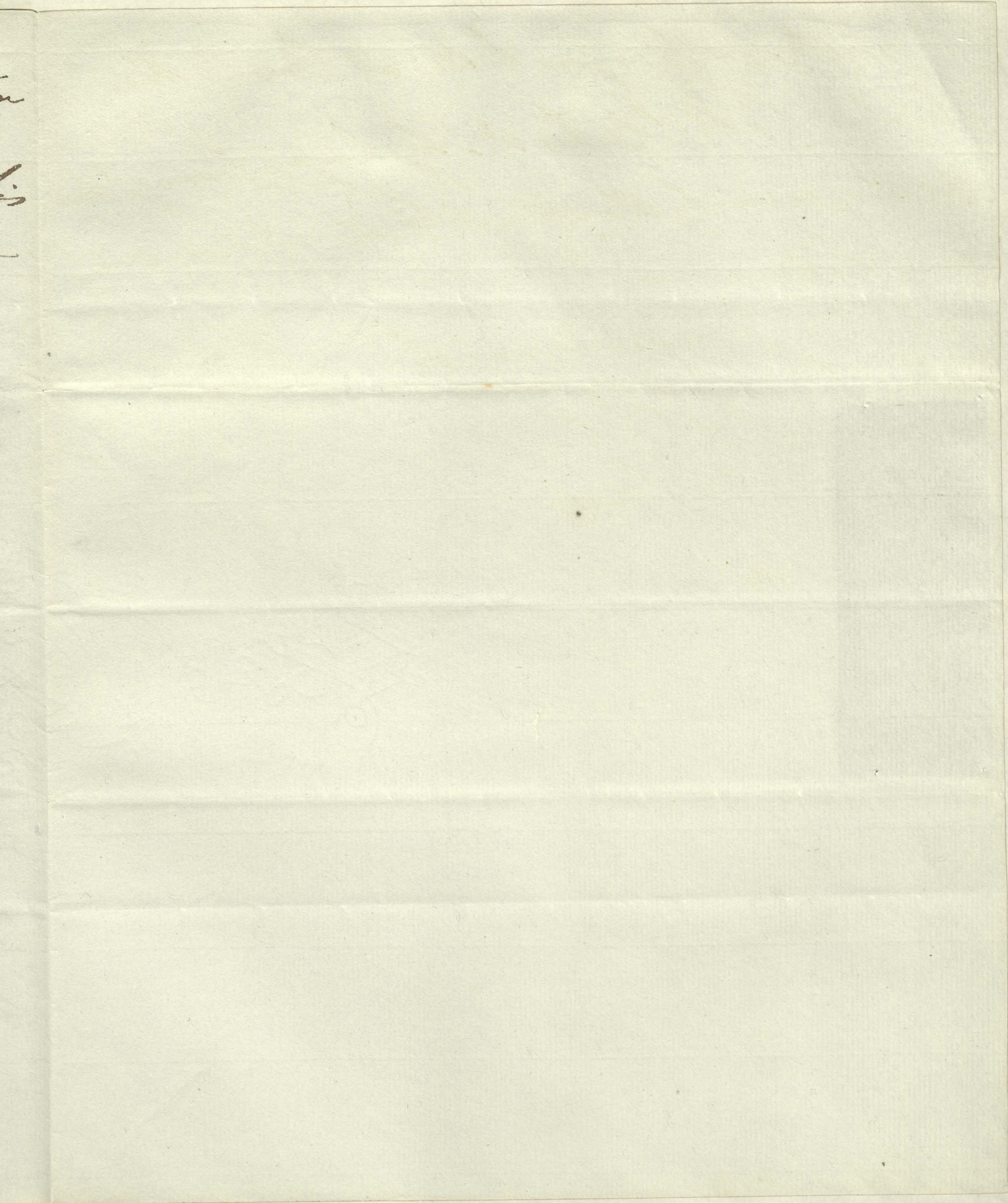
I yesterday received yours of
