

[Dec. 1805 - see previous letter]

Princeps Augustus has received the
 King's commands to acquaint Sir Wil-
 liam Penn that His Majesty is very
 much pleased with the account he
 sent him yesterday of the State of the Bay
 and Harpiches.

Princeps Augustus took an opportunity
 of writing to the King that as late as
 today - at twelve o'clock Sir William had
 not had any answer from Goodville and
 that he would attend in court on Friday next
 and therefore has obtained His Majesty's
 permission for Sir William to send to
 Goodville immediately to perform in the
 place in case Goodville should be pre-
 sented tomorrow.

Princeps Augustus hopes that this will
 save Sir William some unnecessary
 waiting the first Victrolle.

The Duke of Cambridge will be much obli-
 ged to Sir William if he can attend
 to see to stand in the Queen's court on
 every the afternoon of the day.
