Sir

I am commanded by the
Queen to inform you that Her Majesty
wishes you to be at Windsor on Sunday next.
She will not keep you long, but she would com-
mune with you about a Musical Entertainment
she intends giving the King at Frogmore -
Her Majesty has already engaged Mr Billing-
ton, Boulton & Harrison. It is not to take
place till the week after next but she wishes
your Opinion as to the pitcher of the place.
She intends it to be performed in - you may
expect upon not being detained here long.
