Lord North, The advice given by You this morning to Mr. Eden was perfectly agreeable to the contents of Mr. de Goyennes letter, but it certainly alluded to the Plan formed in April; for the enclosed dispatch of a later date proves that the scheme of changing the constitution of Sweden is to be attempted in the course of this month agreeable to the dispatch & communicated to Lord North on Friday, which caused the transmitting that account by that night's packet to Sir John Goddricke; You will send the enclosed dispatch when You have perused it to Mr. Eden.
