Lord Rochford who was gone a few miles out of Town
did not see the last intercepts until this morning,
and is humbly of opinion that it will be much the safest
way to send a messenger and by a letter Mr Eden has
received from Lord North, his lordship seems to wish a
messenger should be sent, and if your Majesty should
approve of it he shall set off as soon as your Majesty
has approved of the inclosed Draught, in which your
Majesty will, it is hoped think all the intercepts have
been fully analysed and that Mr John Goodricke will
have all the requisite information.
