Lord Rockford is under the greatest Confusion at being obliged to be so troublesome but the inclosed Letter he has received from Lord North is of too serious a nature for him to omit communicating it to your Majesty. Lord Rockford takes the Liberty at the same time to trouble your Majesty with his answer to Lord North and to inform your Majesty that he purposes to take no further Steps in this Business untill he hears again from Lord Gower being desirous to do every thing to the utmost of his power that he thinks most conducive to your Majesty's service.
