Sovereign Lord,

The Royal Military Order universal acknowledged and proved in the present day, to be the very Order of the only King of all Kings — Sovereign of all Sovereigns, even expressly instituted by him self (a) in his once visible Person, is the first and principal Object of this fifth Circulatory Sheet which I have the honour to present the most respectfully to your Sacred Majesty. This very Object concerning the most Sensibly all Nations, and therefore the Sovereign of every one of them, intitles us to the hope that you will honour with your Royal attention every Article belonging to it, being all of them distinguished by a red Line at the Margin, besides it's Special Mark &c, in order that you may know at first Sight —. It's last Article at the end of the fifth Page and the beginning of the Sixth, mentions the affectuous approbation given by the KING of France to a first Memorial on it's account and that of the Marshal of Saxe who took upon him self to present that Memorial to his Majesty, as having had a fore meaning of the important uses of that divin Order in the Armies (a). The same Order having been buryed like with this one of the Greatest Generals in the World, raises now by it's present Circulatory Publications, vanquishing by them the deadly Silence of it's Enemies, the same Enemies of Mankind (b).

The two last Pages of the same Circulatory Sheet contain two demonstrative Figures, viz one of the false and the other of the true Distance of the Sun from Earth, both demonstrated by the present Discovery of the Quadrature of the Circle, which appearing under the Auspices of your Sacred Majesty, as dedicated to you, and contradicted by none of the professed Learned of any Nation upon a sufficient public Warranty, shall ever make their unfaithful ungrateful Silence (c), equal to the most Sincere and thankfull acknowledgement with regard of that Object, as well as of the likewise ever uncontrasted present Discovery of Longitude happened in the manner foretold by the famous Sir Isaac Newton, to the Glory of [the universal Principle (c)] and Sovereign Master our God, Principle and Master of all Arts, Sciences, and Languages (d), and to the everlasting Benefit of all Nations (e). 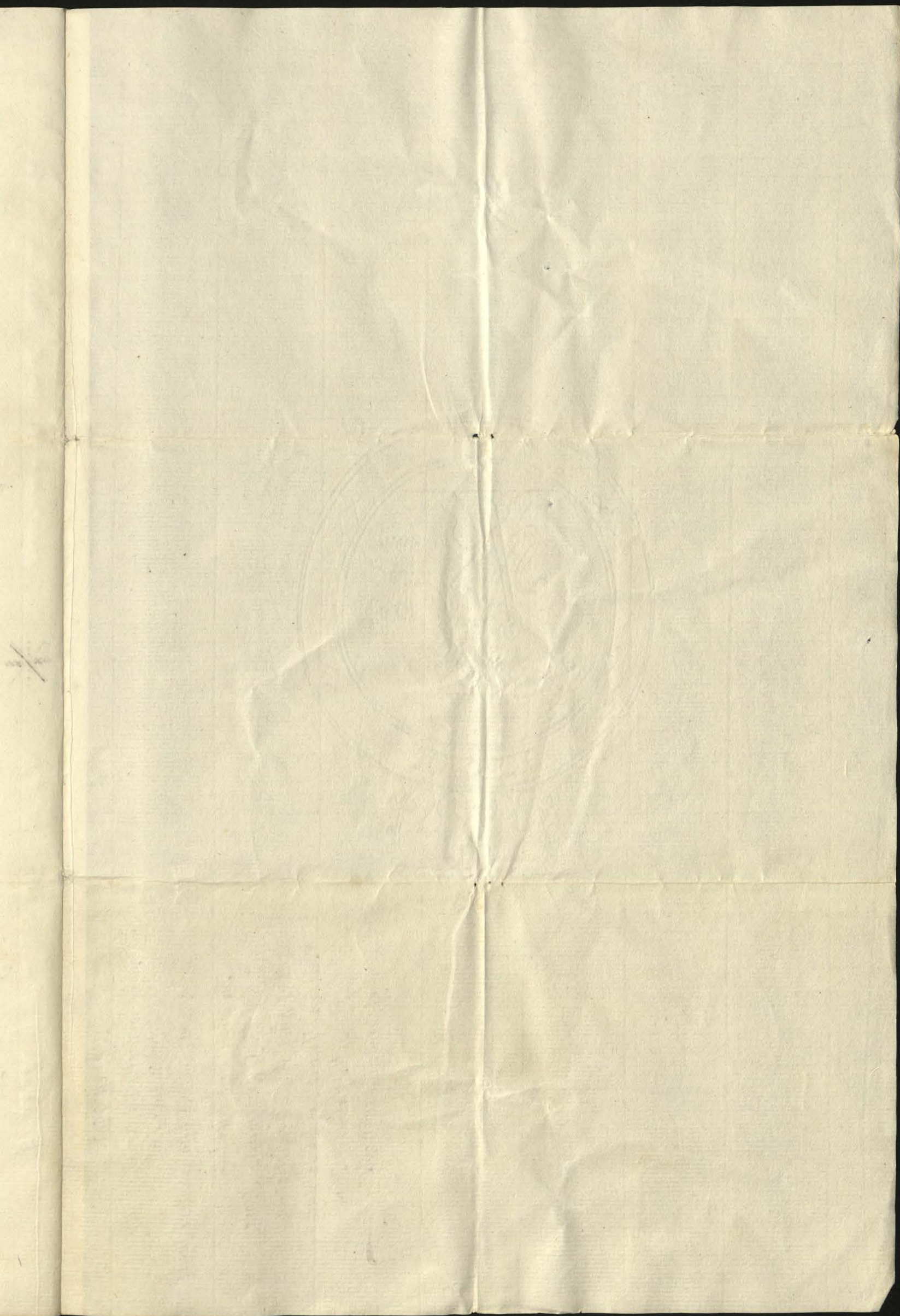
