Lord North, Having received Your letter recommending Doctor Vivian at the request of Lord Suffolk to succeed Doctor Kelly Regius Professor of Physick at Oxford, I empower You to direct a Warrant to be prepared in his favour; I am thoroughly resolved that these employments at both Universities shall be faithfully administered not held as sinecures; therefore the Gentlemen must be acquainted that He will be required to read such a number of Lectures as the Heads of Houses may think necessary.

I take this opportunity of enclosing to You a List of the Servants that I find absolutely necessary to place about My third and fourth Sons now I put two Preceptors to attend them; I have very carefully brought the expence as low as the nature of the thing would admit.

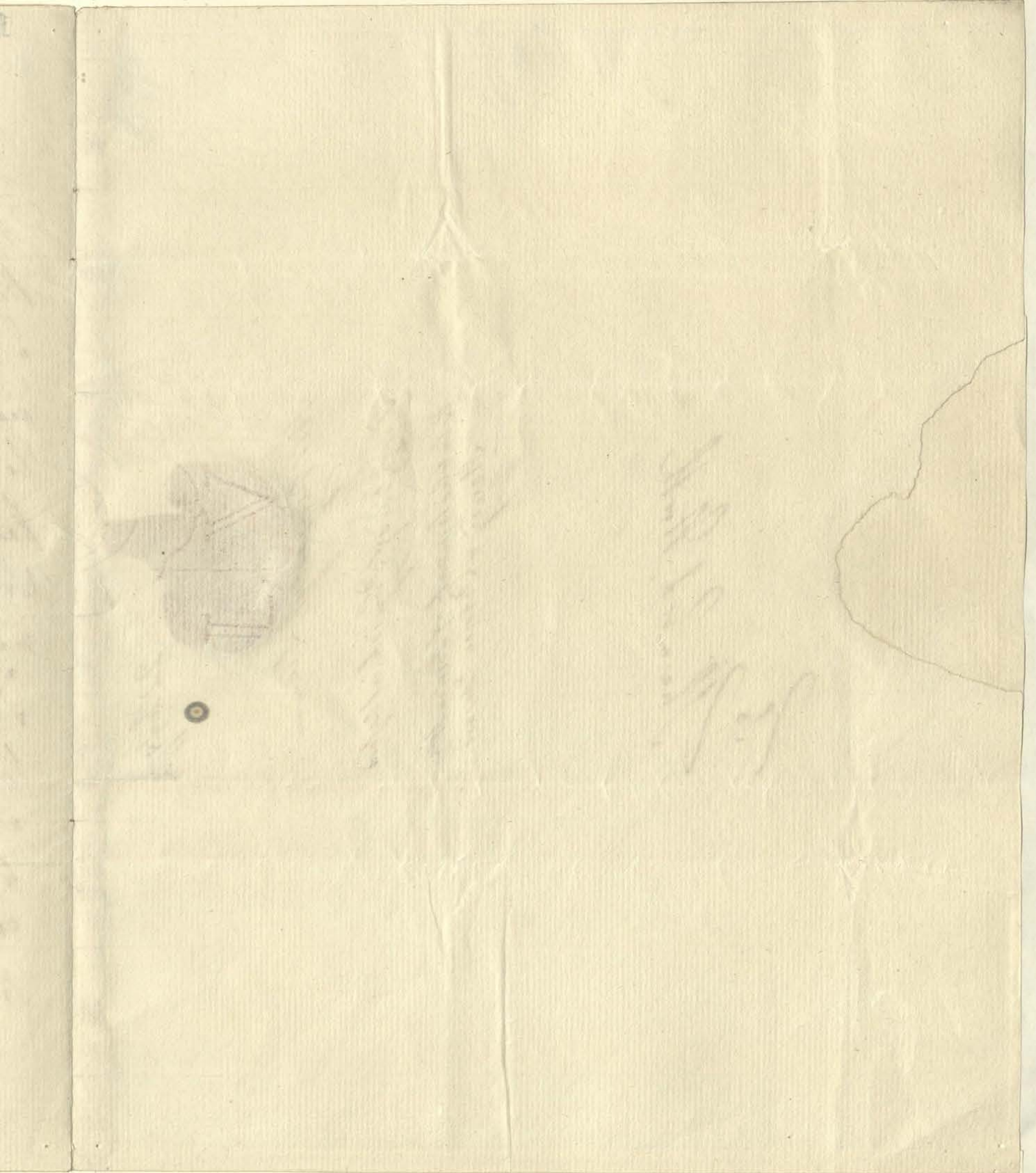
