John Swonshire House Apr. 9. 1761

I was yesterday by the Kings  
order to pay my Duty to your Royal High-  
ness, to deliver the enclosed Papers, & was  
likewise directed to acquaint your Royal  
Highness, that if you approv'd of the valua-  
tion, His Majesty wou'd purchase them, but  
as the sum was so large, it wou'd be very  
inconvenient to make the Payment at once.  
& therefore His Majesty proposes to pay the  
Money at such different Periods as shall  
be agreed upon; I acquainted the King that  
your Royal Highness was not in Town, & have  
receiv'd His Majestys directions to forward the enclosed  
Papers to Windsor. I have the honour to be with the greatest  
respect. S<sup>t</sup> Your Royal Highness
