

At the Council Chamber Whitehall
the 17th of September 1761 -

Minutes of the Lords of the Committee of
Council appointed to consider of the
Coronation -

The Reverse of the Queens Medal - Approved
Ordered that instead of 500 Gold Medals of the King
for the House of Commons there be struck 550. -

A Scheme of the Procession to their Majestys
Coronation - Read and Approved -

The King and Queens Regalia - Approved -

Ordered that besides the Tables in the Hall private
Tables be provided. -

The Surveyor General of the Works having represented to
the Lords that the Concourse of People was so great near
Westminster Hall and Abby, that Plumbers had broke
in and obstructed the Workmen, and Lord Ligomier being
present sent Orders in Writing to the Tith Officer in
Waiting to send an Officer and 40 Men to the Hall
and the like Number to the Abby - And the Lords issued
an Order to the High Constable of Westminster to use his
best Endeavours to prevent such Interruption for the
future. -

Several General Orders were given to the Earl Marshall
for the better regulating the Solemnity of the Coronation

Ordered that the Dean and Chapter of Westminster do for them deliver to the Earl Marshall or his Order the Keys of the North Door, South East Door, Choir Door and any other Private Doors leading to the Choir, and that they do not keep Duplicates of the Keys nor suffer the Locks to be forced or broke —

Ordered that the Surveyor General of the Works be directed to make sufficient Room for the Trumpets Drums and Musick where the Organ stood over the Choir Door and that the rest of the Organ loft be appropriated to the Use of the Church in such Manner as the Earl Marshall shall direct —

Ordered that Lord High Steward have two Persons to attend him —

Ordered that Lord Steward of His Majesty's Household do appoint a sufficient Number of Persons to wait at the several Tables at Dinner in the Hall, and to have Pass Tickets from the Lord Great Chamberlain —

Ordered that the Lords Spiritual have five Tickets instead of four —

Ordered that a Table be provided near the Side Board on the left Side of Westminster Hall for the Lord Mayor Commonalty and Citizens —

Ordered that the High Bailiff of Westminster & Justices of the Peace do prevent any kind of Fire Works in Westminster on the Day of the Coronation —
