 but also to require you to repair to Our said
 Castle, then and there to proceed to their
 Installations, according to the Statutes and
 laudable Customs of Our said Order. Given at Our
 Court at St. James's under Our Sign Manual, and
 Signet of Our said Order, this 8. Day of Sept: 1762,
 in the Second Year of Our Reign.
