Madam

I have just received the enclosed letter from the Princess  
of Brunswick accompanying two from the Duke of Brunswick  
to the Hereditary Prince, by them you will see that if she  
comes over this year it will occasion a breach in that Family  
I am certain you will think nothing could justify that, and  
the more so, as if you should comply with the desire my  
sister has this Autumn, repeatedly expressed of in the course  
of next Summer making her a visit, probably but little  
difficulty could be made at Brunswick of her attending  
you back; I have here stated what occurs to Me as the  
best means to ease my sister's mind, without affecting her  
future happiness, and will not encroach longer on your time  
but to express that I shall ever remain
