The King having received Your Royal Highnesses letter in which Your Royal Highness says You cannot disavow the step You have taken, His Majesty has ordered me for fear his intentions should not have been clearly understood to convey to Your Royal Highness his sentiments which are that a disavowal of Your marriage was not expected, all that was meant was that the Lady should never take any other Name or rank than that of Mrs. Horton, and on that condition alone as I had the honour to tell Your Royal Highness at Alton as the King had declared he could or could not admit Your Royal Highness into his presence.
