Lord North, The letter I received this day from You in answer to mine of yesterday, is the most ample proof of Your affectionate feelings for me. The Bishop of Litchfield has with great modesty and propriety agreed to come as Preceptor to my Children; I shall therefore direct Lord Bruce and Him to come and kiss hands at the Levee on Friday. I wish You would communicate my last letter to Lord Dartmouth as I am desirous he should exactly know the springs on which I have acted.
