7. That the Admiral is to appoint
 a proper Officer to go with him
 at such times as the Admiral
 may think it right to send
 him to sail in small Vessels
 as also when he goes to swim

1^o That I entrust my Dear & beloved
 Lord P. William to his care, and give
 Instructions for the care of the
 Admirals mind.

2^o That He is to be thoroughly
 instructed in every branch of Nautical
 knowledge, and obliged to perform
 most rigidly every duty of the Station
 in which he is placed on board of
 the Admirals Ship.

3^o That as proper Lieut. he always
 on the Watch when it is his
 duty who must report very
 exactly how he has behaved, and
 that he be early taught obedience
 and to conduct himself with
 politeness.

4^o As I wish the other branches
 of Education necessary for him
 when on Shore may not be
 neglected, I have sent the Rev.
 Mr. Majendie with him to
 pursue his Studies, the Admirals
 to see that this be constantly
 attended to.

5^o That he is to be treated with
 civility but no marks of respect
 to receive no visits, and never dine
 from on board the Ship but
 with the Commander in Chief
 and that but seldom.

6^o Never to go on Shore but with
 the Admirals
