thing I wou'd wish him. He has been  
in great spirits at our having this

consisting of one Ship of 64 guns w<sup>th</sup>  
4 Frigates of 32, 30, 28, & 26 w<sup>th</sup> two smaller  
and 16 Vessels w<sup>th</sup> Stores for Cadiz, and taken  
every one of them His M<sup>ty</sup> Highness writes

To your Majesty - I shall therefore  
add no more but that I am
