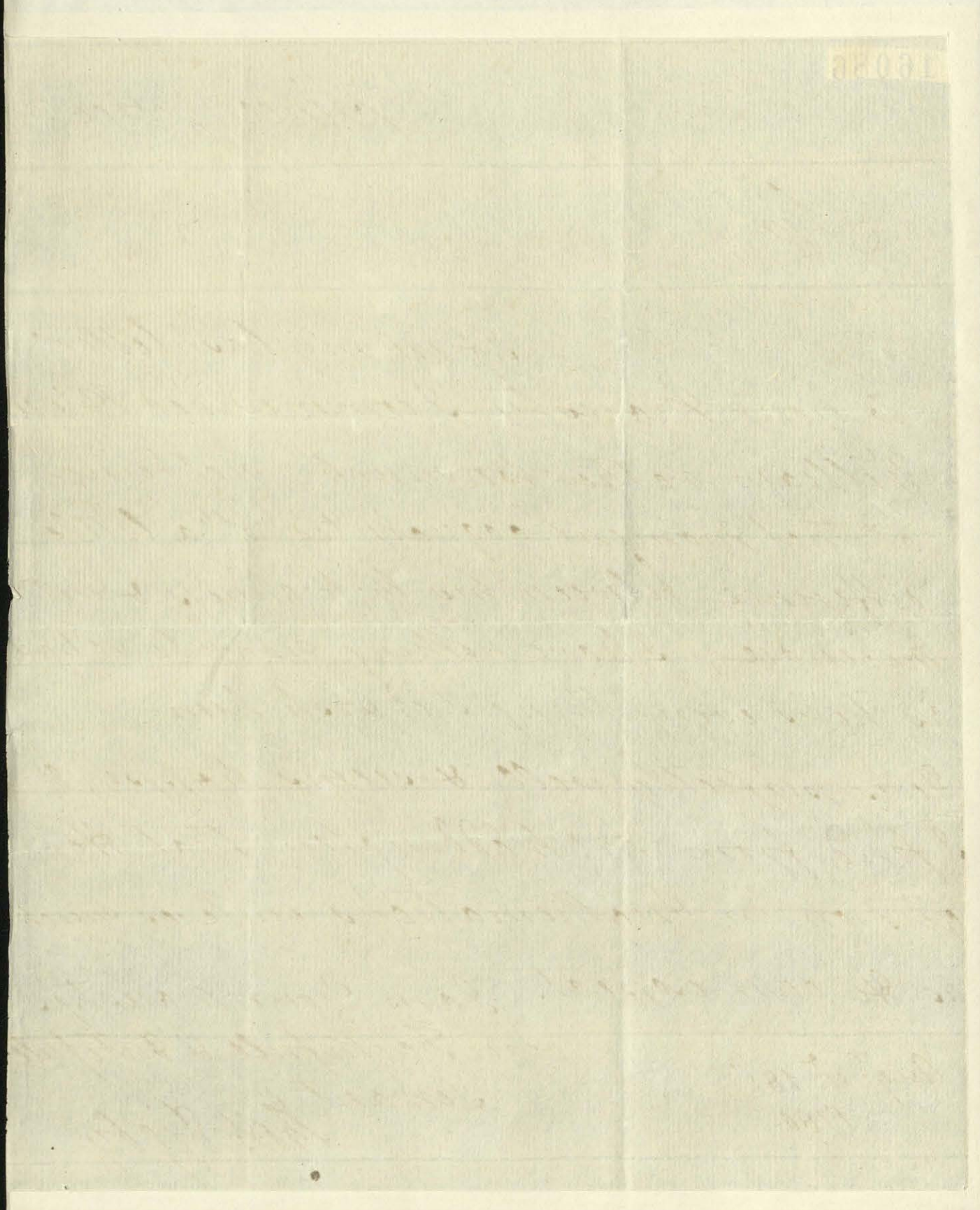
Sir
