About two, in the morning, 16<sup>th</sup>  
Her Majesty, being taken  
in labour, my pages were

in the great Council Chamber at St James's  
 By His Grace, the Archbishop

 the presence of their Majesties  
 the whole Royal Family, as  
 a very illustrious assembly  
 of the nobility and foreign  
 Ministers. The sponsors  
 were, his Royal Highness, the  
 Duke of Gloucester, Prince  
 Augustus Frederick, and the  
 Princess of Brunswick
