



1774. February.

24th. This day, at five o'clock
in the afternoon, Her
Majesty was taken in Labour,
and at a quarter past six,
was safely delivered of a
Prince.

March

24th This evening the
christening of the young
Prince, was performed in
the great Council Chamber,
by the Archbishop of York.
His Royal Highness was
named Adolphus Frederick.

2

April. 1776.

23th About six in the morning, Her Majesty was taken with labour pains, notice of which, was immediately sent to the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Secretaries of State, and several of the nobility; and at seven o'clock Her Majesty was safely delivered of a Princess, being her eleventh child, and all of them living.

2

November 1779.

3^d This evening about nine o'clock, the Queen was happily delivered of a Princess. His Grace, the Archbishop of Canterbury, several Lords of Her Majesty's most hon: Privy Council, and the Ladies of Her Majesty's Bedchamber, were present.

December.

1st This evening, the young Princess was baptized in the Council-Chamber, at St James's, by the Archbishop of Canterbury, by the name

of Sophia. There was a
great number of the
nobility present.

March 1779.

20th This evening, the ceremony
of the christening of the
young Prince, was performed
in the great Council-chamber
at James's, by His Grace, the
Archbishop of Canterbury.

His Royal Highness was named
Octavius.
