Patent in this behalf bearing date the 6 day of June 1761
These are to pray & require your Grace to make and pass
Debentures for paying unto Martha Bonfoy Widow Housekeeper
of His Majesty's Palace at Newmarket or her Assigns the
Sum of Fifty Pounds without account for one Quarter of
a year ended the 5 day of July 1782 on her Wages & Fees
of Two hundred Pounds per Annum And let the same
be satisfied out of any Money in the Receipt of the
Sacheyer applicable to the Use of his Majesty's Civil
Government For which this shall be your Grace's Command
Whitehall Treasury Chambers the 25 day of November
1782
