I must do His Royal Highness the justice, to say, that He has upon this occasion followed the Doctors Advice most strictly, & if He will only consent to manage Himself a little in some time to come, I am persuaded He will escape a relapse of which there is no danger, according to Dr Zimmerman's opinion, provided His Royal Highness uses the necessary precautions.
