An open Breach with Me is but one among  
the many and still greater Mischiefs  
which the Step <sup>the P. of W.</sup> you seems misled enough  
to take probably leads to. The Precipita-  
-tion with which <sup>we</sup> have been advised  
to preclude all Communication with  
Me on the Subject of <sup>His</sup> Leaving this  
or of the Circumstances <sup>his</sup> manner of going to  
Kingdom, and the abrupt and offensive  
manner which has been recommended  
to <sup>him</sup> of announcing this Purpose, could  
not fail, in the first Instance of producing  
that Effect. The Consideration of the  
farther Evils which I foresee from <sup>the P. of W.</sup> your  
executing this Design makes me think  
it necessary as <sup>His</sup> Father and <sup>His</sup>

Sovereigns, strictly to charge and comma  
nd <sup>by this Paper</sup> not to leave the Realm without  
having obtained my particular leave
