Support of a Message delivered by M<sup>r</sup> Lyke, from  
His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales, to Colonel  
Attham, on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1787. —

On the 4<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1787, M<sup>r</sup> Lyke brought Colonel Attham a verbal  
message from His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales, importing, that  
His Appointment of M<sup>r</sup> Hammersley as His Banker was subsequent  
to the Dissolution of His Establishment on the 7<sup>th</sup> July last.

That His Royal Highness did not wish Colonel Attham should quit His  
Service; but that, if His Exalted Highness did not permit Him to comply with the  
Prince's Plan, already mentioned, in consideration of His long & faithful  
Services, His Royal Highness desired Colonel Attham to accept of £1000  
per Annum upon His quitting His Royal Highness's Service. —
