Sir

I had the honor of laying before your Majesty, on my return from Gibraltar, the arrangement, which his Royal Highness, Prince Edward, had adopted, with respect to his finances, and the order his Royal Highness, then gave me, to appropriate three thousand Pounds, out of his Income, for the payment of his Debts

I have now the honor to acquaint your Majesty, that his Royal Highness's intentions, have been carried into Effect, and that

Three thousand pounds, have since that Period
been paid, in which, are included, the whole of
his Royal Highness's Debts, at Gibraltar.

I feel it my Duty, further to acquaint
your Majesty, that his Royal Highness, has
directed me, to continue the Application of two
thousand pounds per annum, out of his
Income, to pay such Debts in London, as were
contracted by his Royal Highness, previous to
his Departure for Canada, and to which there
has since, been no Addition —
