negative. Vocs. 170. Ayes. 40. The Debate
upon the Question for passing the Bill lasted

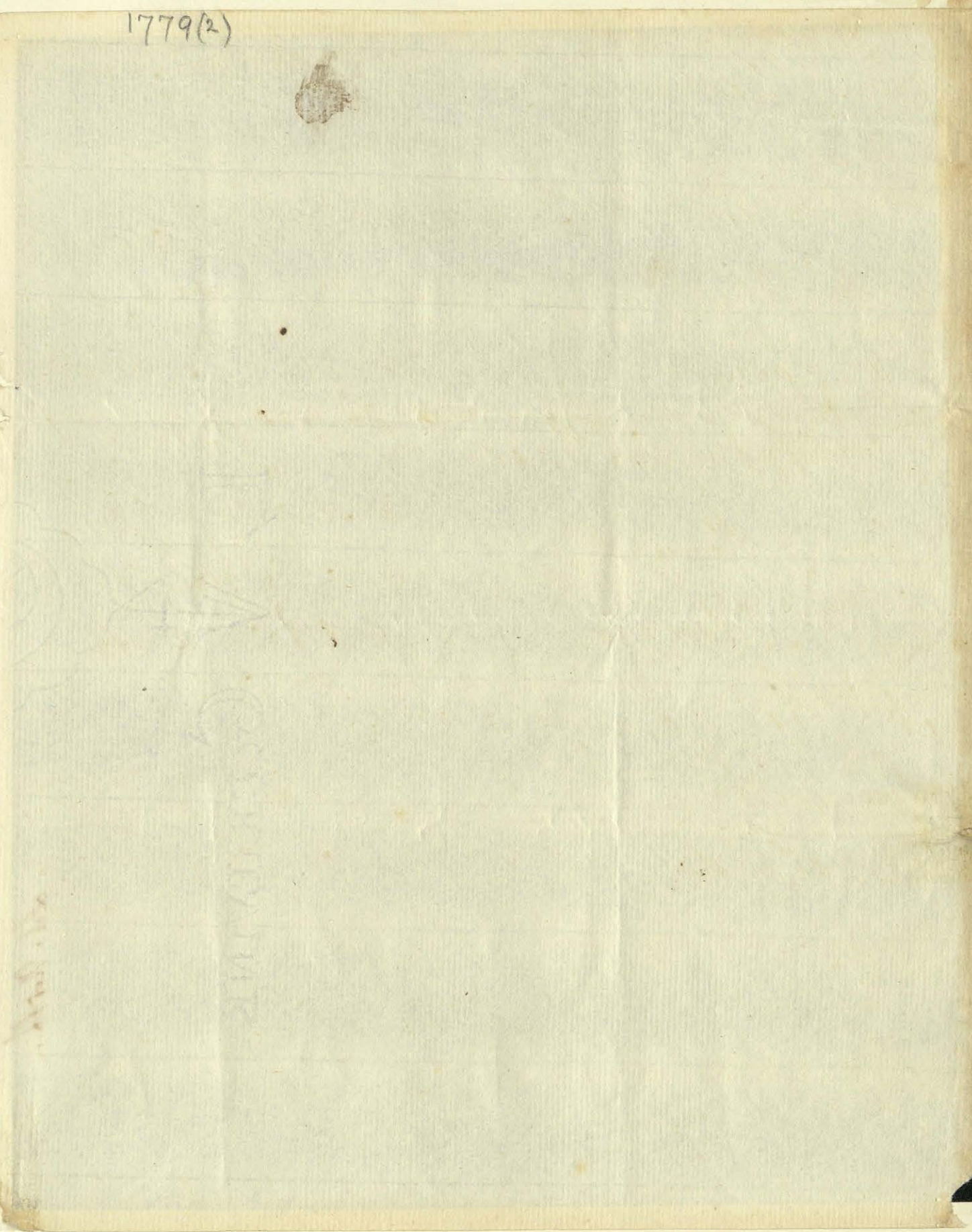
