M^r J. W. Plummer has the honor to present his most respectful duty to the Prince Regent, & to inform your Royal Highness that he yesterday saw the Comte Delachasse, Minister of the Comte de Lille - who on being apprized of the intimation M^r Plummer had the honor to receive from your Royal Highness respecting the examination of the sealed packets found among the D'Or papers, addressed "au Roi seul à Paris" - gave his immediate assent on behalf of the Comte de Lille to the mode proposed. of this M^r Plummer has informed the Marquis of Wellesley who holds himself in readiness to proceed on the examination whenever required.

M^r Plummer also takes the liberty of presenting to your Royal Highness his most respectful acknowledgments for your great condescension when he had the honor of an interview - & will at all times be happy to wait upon your Royal Highness on receiving your commands - but having been favored with the option of either to day or Monday for next being at Carlton House - M^r Plummer would most respectfully submit to your Royal Highness that he be allowed to defer his next attendance till after Wednesday - having some particular business which in the interior requires his absence from town - but this is only mentioned in perfect deference to your Royal Highness's convenience, M^r Plummer readily putting off the other engagement if it should be more agreeable to your Royal Highness that he attend on Monday next as proposed.
