Lord Wellesley has the honor to submit to your Royal Highness the draft of an Instruction to Mr Foster, on the subject of the differences which have arisen with the United States, respecting the affair of the Chesapeake Frigate.

The terms offered in this draft had been discussed with Mr Pinkney in the course of the last Summer, & he had

had stated that they would probably
be satisfactory to the United States.
