June 25th 1806

Dear Charles

Genl. Doyle has been introduced to you
by Lord Moira — I know the value of that recommenda-
tion, and that it cannot be enhanced — Nevertheless, I
must introduce him as a friend of mine, as one
whose honorable Conduct has stood in his way even
in his profession of a Soldier for many years — He was
placed by me in a Civil employment of considerable
responsibility, and after my leaving Ireland was
removed from it for an honorable adherence to my
measures — Much was done to persuade him
to abandon them, but all produced no effect upon
his honorable Mind.
