Mr Perceval presents his Compliments
to Colonel Macmahon and begs
to inform him that he has
learnt since he had the pleasure
of seeing Colonel Macmahon this
morning, that the Lord Chancellor
will not be able to prepare the
Commission for the prorogation
unless the order in Council
is made Tomorrow, instead of

on Wednesday. Mr Percival hopes
that this alteration will not
be attended with the smallest
inconvenience to His Royal Highness,
and Mr Percival, if His Royal
Highness will permit him, will
wait upon His Royal Highness
between one and half past two
o'clock tomorrow.
