I this morning received
a very kind note from Mr. Goshal acquainting
that a Permission was to take place on
the first of August, to the end of 1793,
& requesting to know my determination
to which I have returned the following
answer, & hope it will meet with your
approbation, & that if you will approve
you will have the goodness to give
me your interest in His Royal Highness

should it be necessary - Mr. Yorke having
made the communication to me in
the most confidential manner; I trans-
mit this to him, in his permission to
its being forwarded - I am obliged to
send my answer by this Post, I being
in the midst of paying the Yard, & other
business, and as embarking to-morrow for
Patagonia, I am very much hurried -
