Sir

A few days ago Mr. J. Harrison who is engaged to write Lord Nelson's life in which he requires my assistance, informed me, that there was in his Lordship's own hand writing a plan to prevent invasion, which he wished to present to his Royal Highness the Prince Regent; took the liberty of acquainting Lord Mordaunt of this, and requested he would present it to the Prince; Lord Mordaunt desired me to address Mr. Harrison on the subject, I did so, and he desired that the plan might be given to you - Mr. Harrison now waits on you with it; I am glad to be the means of conveying any thing to the Prince Regent which may be serviceable to the Country and agreeable to his Royal Highness; have no other merit in



this matter than introducing Mr. Thomson  
to you to present the Man —
