Mr Perceval presents his humble Duties  
to your Royal Highness, and has the satisfaction  
to acquaint your Royal Highness, that, after  
some little conversation between Mr Perceval, Mr  
Turney, Mr. Adam, Mr Pryder, & Mr. Whitbread  
the vote for a Grant of 100,000 for the expenses  
incidental to the assumption of the Regency, passed  
in the Committee of Supply this Evening without a  
Division. - Mr Turney suggested that it should  
be expressed to be for the expenses incurred & to be  
incurred in consequence of assuming the Regency,  
and Mr Perceval's acceding to those words was  
the occasion of preventing a Division which would  
otherwise have taken place. -

Mr Turney said that the Motion which was  
to have been made next Monday by Lord Geo  
Cavendish, respecting the Roman Catholics, would  
be put off, and probably not come on before
