Ld Liverpool has the honor to inform  
your Royal Highness, that Mr Douglas  
is arrived this morning with dispatches  
from Lord William Bentinck, dated 21<sup>st</sup>  
25<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>r</sup> containing the intelligence  
of the Royal Act having been signed by  
the King of Sicily on the 18<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>r</sup> ap-  
pointing the Provisional Prince Vicar  
General of the Kingdom, with the whole  
of the Royal authority, and that on  
the 19<sup>th</sup> of the said month the Provisional  
Prince had appointed Lord William  
Bentinck Cap<sup>t</sup> General in Sicily, and  
Major Gen<sup>l</sup> Macpherson second in  
Command. In consequence of this

Royal Highnesses spent a part of the  
British Army had been ordered to  
Palermo, and were expected to arrive  
in a few days

The Sicilian Passports which were  
furnished in the month of July last  
had been recalled by the Secretary
