My Dear Mr. Mahon

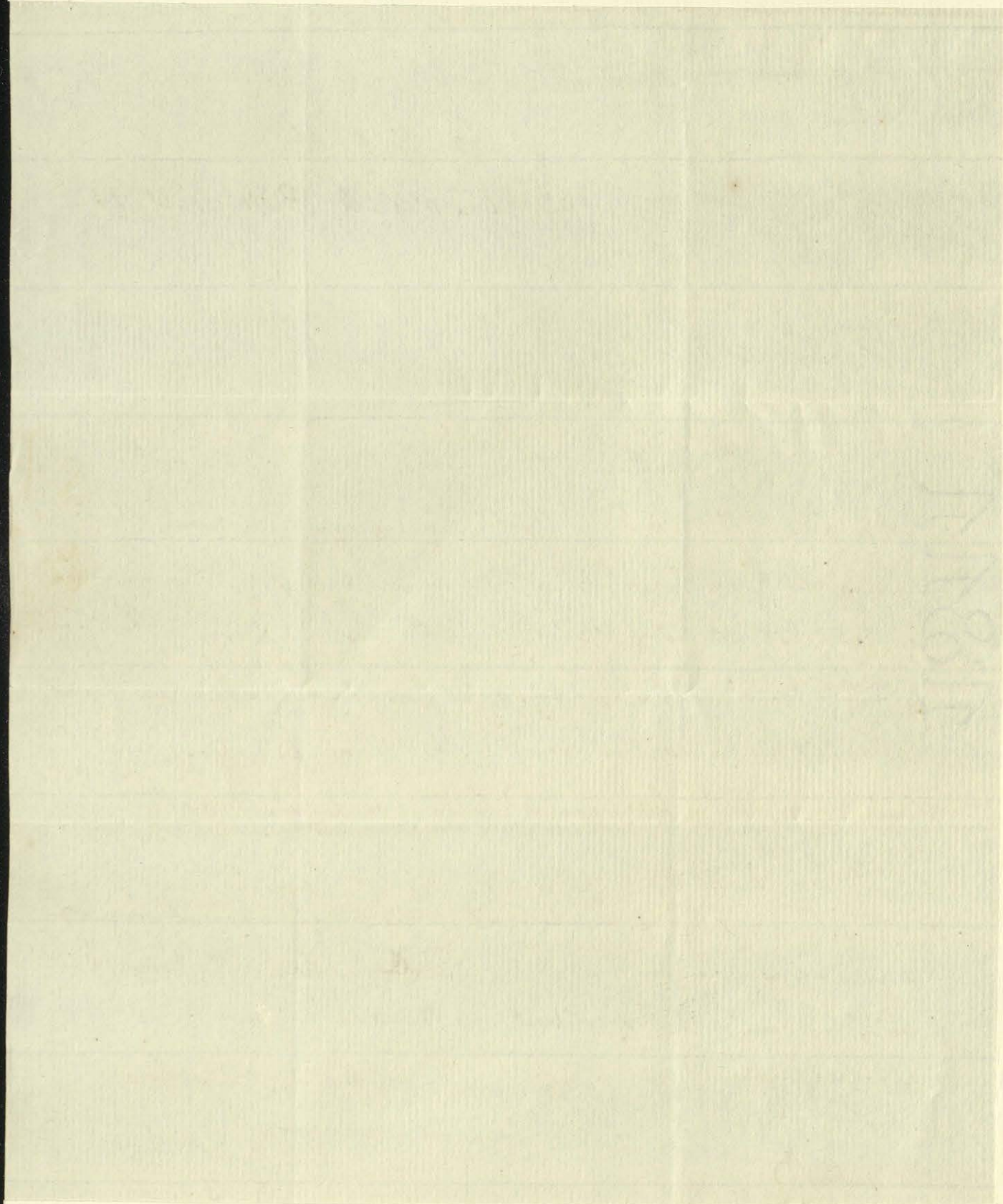
