The accompanying warrant which is most humbly submitted to the Secretary at War for your Royal Highness's signature is founded upon the report of the Board of Cavalry Officers of which His Royal Highness The Duke of Cumberland was President; This Warrant does not contain all the matter of that report, as some of its pecuniary details have not yet been brought into a shape in which they could be submitted to your Royal Highness, but they will be so digested with all possible dispatch.

The present warrant comprizes those regulations respecting the clothing & appointments, to which your Royal Highness's sanction must be obtained, to enable the Cavalry to equip themselves for the ensuing campaign.
