On my return from the House
of Commons last night I had the
honour to receive the Prime Minister's
command that I should take into my
consideration a scandalous process set
in the British Press of yesterday. I found
at the same time a reference from
the Secretary of State touching a
paragraph upon the same subject in
the Morning Chronicle of the 9th inst.
& perhaps it will be most convenient
that we should report upon them together.
I would not however presume this
course without knowing whether it
meets His Royal Highness's pleasure,
& this you can probably inform
me without troubling His Royal
Highness again.
