A Copy Treasury Chamber 6th Dec^r 1811

Sir,

"In answer to your further applications for this sum of pay
 " as Commissary for Prisoners of War at Buenos Ayres; I have it in
 " Command from the Lords Comm^{rs} of His Majesty's Treasury to inform
 " You that My Lords can only repeat to you, that the Service for
 " which you claim payment are entirely of a Naval description,
 " to be compensated out of Funds Voted by Parliament for the
 " use of the Navy, and therefore Their Lordships could not with
 " any propriety interfere."
